

### Margherita Sarfatti by Stephen Contrado, B.A., Th.M.

Margherita Sarfatti was born Margherita Grassini in Venice on April 8, 1880. She was the daughter of Amedeo Grassini and Emma Levi. She grew up in a palazzo by the Canal Grande in Venice and was educated by private tutors. Hers was a conservative bourgeois childhood, but she soon took an interest in the political and the artistic controversies of the day. She left home at age 18 to marry Cesare Sarfatti, a Jewish lawyer from Padua, who was 13 years her senior.

Her father, Amedeo, was a wealthy Jewish lawyer and businessman who worked as a fiscal attorney for the Venetian government. He was knighted in the Order of the Crown of Italy. He was also a close friend of Giuseppe Melchiorre Sarto, who later became Pope Pius X.

In 1902 she and her husband moved to Milan. They became prominent in the city's artistic life, hosting salons there that became the nucleus of the Futurist and Novecento Italiano artistic movements. They had several children. Their eldest son, Robert, enlisted in the Italian army during World War I, and was killed in action on Monte Baldo in 1918, aged 18.

Sarfatti became a well-known journalist, art critic and collector, socialite, and propaganda adviser of the National Fascist Party. She was Benito Mussolini's biographer, and also became one of his mistresses. Benito Mussolini was three years her junior. The biography of Mussolini published in 1925 was a success. Seventeen editions were printed, and it was translated into 18 languages.

Sarfatti came to the United States to sell Mussolini to the American people, which she did that through William Randolph Hearst's press, the nation's largest newspaper chain, as she socialized wealthy Americans.

She left Italy in 1938 for Argentina and Uruguay and worked as a journalist for the newspaper El Diario of Montevideo. After the war, in 1947, she returned to her native land and again became influential in Italian art. She died October 30, 1961, aged 81.

Actress Susan Sarandon portrayed Sarfatti in the 1999 movie Cradle Will Rock. Roberto Festorazzi wrote a book about Sarfatti titled La Donna che intento' Mussolini (The woman who invented Mussolini) published in 2010.






